ANTIFREEZE	Used antifreeze	Antifreeze collection section - <u>upper level</u>
BATTERIES	Vehicle, boat, motorcycle	Batteries collection section - <u>upper level</u>
	ALL household batteries (alkaline, lithium, NiCd, NiMh, etc.)	Batteries collection section - <u>lower level</u>
BOAT WRAP	Boat shrink wrap	Ask attendant
BOOKS	Good quality books in readable condition (<i>torn or tattered - not hardcover - place in Single Stream</i>)	Book Shack - <u>lower level</u>
CLOTHING, SHOES, LINENS	Clean, usable clothing and shoes	Goodwill Center - <u>lower level</u>
	Clothing, shoes, pocketbooks, linens, accessories. <i>Details at: www.southbury-ct.org/textilerecycling</i>	Bay State Textile Container - <u>lower level</u>
ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT	Computers, monitors, printers, scanners, TVs, and other miscellaneous electronic devices and cables	Electronics collection section - <u>lower level</u>
LIGHT BULBS	Fluorescent, halogen and LEDs - Unbroken (<i>Incandescent bulbs - throw in trash</i>)	Light bulbs collection section - <u>lower level</u>
LEAVES & BRANCHES	Foliage from trees (<i>must be debagged once delivered</i>)	Ask attendant
	Brush and branches No grass clippings	Ask attendant - fees apply
MATTRESS & BOX SPRINGS	Mattresses that are NOT severely damaged, twisted, wet, frozen, soiled or infested with bed bugs	Ask attendant - fees might apply
PAINT	Latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil-based, enamel, deck coatings, floor paints, primers, sealers, etc. <i>See exceptions at: www.southbury-ct.org/paintrecycling</i>	Paint collection section - <u>upper level</u>
PLASTIC BAGS	Plastic shopping bags, plastic wrap	Barrels - <u>lower level</u>
SCRAP METAL	Light scrap metal, white goods, aluminum, copper, brass tools, water tanks, pipes, aluminum siding, copper wire, faucets, propane tanks No fuel oil, gasoline tanks	Ask attendant - fees apply
WASTE OIL	Used crankcase oil No gasoline, automatic transmission fluid, fuel oil, hydraulic oil, parts cleaner, solvents	Oil collection section - <u>upper level</u>
