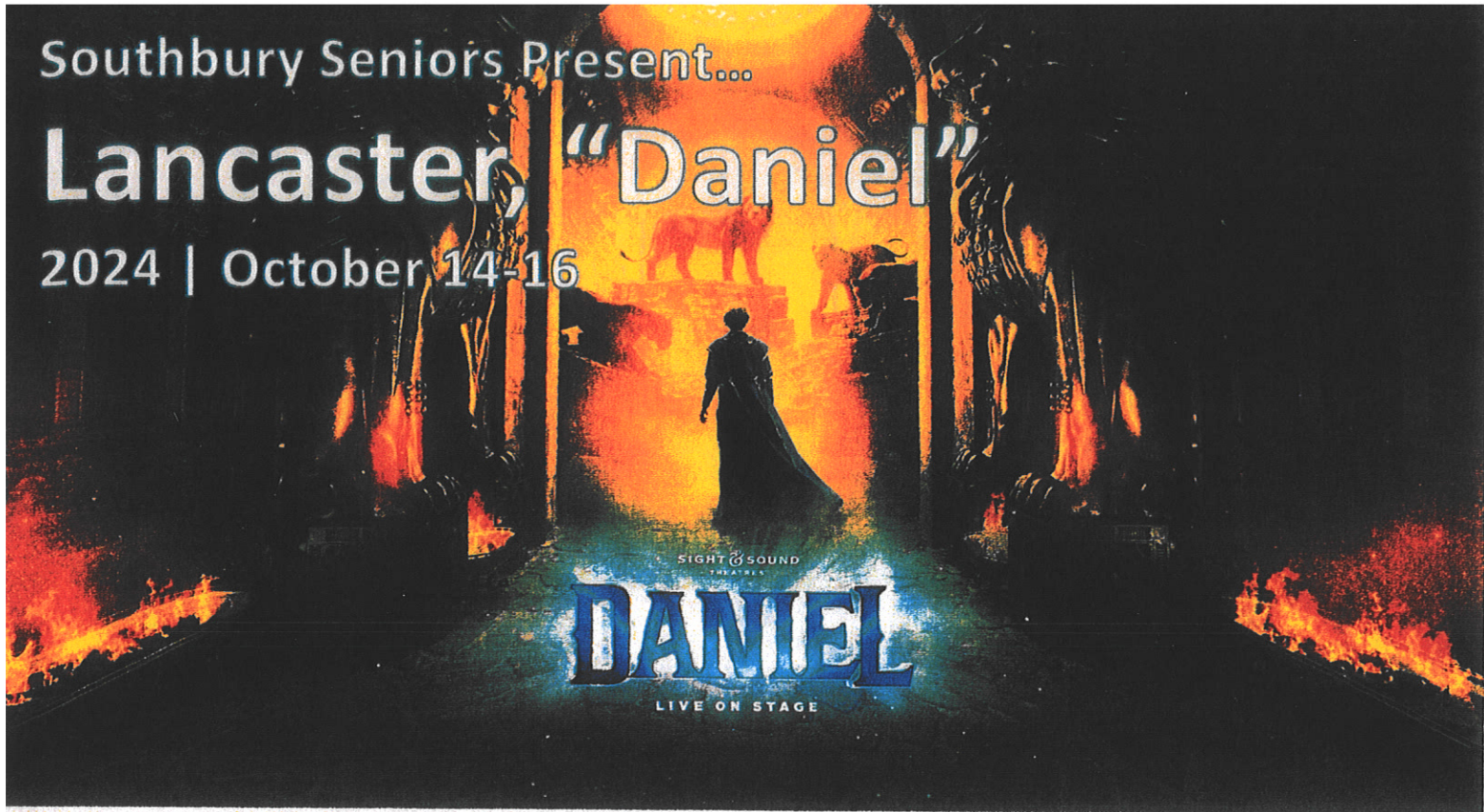


Southbury Seniors Present...

After, we continue over to Kitchen Kettle Village, where we will have fill your tote with culinary favorites, and enjoy lunch in the café. This afternoon we take our reserved orchestra seats for their new production of "Daniel" at Sight & Sound Theatre. Taken from his people, Daniel is exiled far from home in the powerful kingdom of Babylon. Now this faithful servant must navigate his new life inside a palace filled with golden statues and shifting empires. As royal pressures mount, Daniel is faced with a dangerous choice.
