FREE IR Thermometers for Business – any small business in the state that has between 2 and 100 employees are eligible to receive one thermometer per physical address.

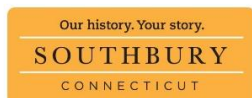
Nonprofits and Places of Worship: are eligible to receive one thermometer per address.
